

Public Hearing Notice for the Certificate of Need Application for the Total Replacement/Relocation of Virtua Memorial Hospital of Burlington County

The State Health Planning Board (the Board) will be holding a public hearing concerning the certificate of need application submitted to the Department of Health by **Virtua Memorial Hospital of Burlington County**. Copies of the application are available for review at the Burlington County Library, the New Jersey State Library, and at the New Jersey Department of Health.

The Board invites the public to comment on the application. All those wishing to make oral comments to the Board are invited to attend the public hearing on this application on **Tuesday, March 14, 2017**. Comments will be limited to three minutes per person, although written comments may also be submitted at the same time. The Board will take comments from **6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. or close of testimony, whichever is later**. The hearing will be held at the **Hilton Garden Inn, Mount Holly/Westampton, 111 Hancock Lane, Westampton, NJ 08060**.

Comments may also be submitted in writing after the hearing. Commenters are urged to make their comments concise. Comments must be received by the State Health Planning Board no later than **Tuesday, March 28, 2017** at the following address:
