TV/COMPUTER RECYCLING OPTIONS

Retailers - If you buy a new TV, the store may take your old one.

Municipal Dropoffs *for their residents only -*

Bordentown City, Cinnaminson, Delran, Evesham, Florence, Maple Shade, Medford Twp., Mt. Laurel, Pemberton Twp., Shamong, Tabernacle and Wrightstown.

Note: *electronics accepted varies by town.*

Municipal Collection Days *for their residents only*

Some towns not listed may offer ewaste collection days - check with your town to see if they do.

Goodwill Donation Centers

Accept small quantities of non-working, intact, TVs and computers **for recycling** - **No businesses or large quantities.**

County Resource Recovery Complex *for residents only - no businesses or non-profits*

Small household appliances such as metal fans, toasters, power tools and vacuums as well as old X-ray films are also accepted at this site.
