

WHEREAS, the hazard mitigation planning process set forth by the State of New Jersey and the Federal Emergency Management Agency offers the opportunity to consider natural hazards and risks, and to identify mitigation actions to reduce future risk;

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management provided federal mitigation funds to support development of the mitigation plan;

WHEREAS, a Burlington County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Mitigation Planning Committee;

WHEREAS, FEMA Region II has approved the *Burlington County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan*; the purpose of this Plan is to reduce the loss of life and property due to natural disaster;

WHEREAS, the implementation of the *Burlington County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan* will protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the (name of municipality) as well as reduce potential damage and shorten the disaster recovery period;

The New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency has funded hundreds of property purchases for lower income homeowners in Burlington County over the past 30 years, some of which unfortunately have gone into foreclosure. The HMFA puts them up for sale to other lower income homeowners but in some cases the properties are not attractive to income qualified homebuyers since they are deed restricted to lower income people but they need to much work and the lenders will not loan on properties that are not habitable "as is". The affordable housing requirements of the state allow such properties to be purchased by non-profits to be rehabbed and rented as affordable housing for income qualified renters.

But, and this is the big BUT. The Township has to approve of the sale to a non-profit since we would not be owner-occupants.

The above referenced property has been vacant for almost two years, has suffered much deterioration before it was foreclosed and might have suffered additional damage due to not being heated in the winter or dehumidified in the summer.

The Salt and Light Company, Inc. would like to obtain this property for rehab and rental. Please consider approving this request and communicate the same to the staff at the NJ HMFA.
