Det. Redfield attended the "2022 Narcotics Training Conference" hosted by the New Jersey Narcotic Enforcement Officers Association from 6/6/22 - 6/10/22 at the Tropicana Hotel in Atlantic City, NJ.

Ptl. Rowbottom attended "Physical & Cyber Security for Critical Infrastructures" hosted by the Department of Homeland Security on 6/8/22 at the Burlington County Emergency Services Training Center.

Ptl. Rowbottom attended an online training, "NJTR-1 Refresher" presented by the NJSP on 6/17/22.

Ptl. Rowbottom attended an online training, "Train the Trainer for Crossing Guards" on 6/22/22.

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DSgt. Chieffalo, Det. Redfield and Ptl. Rowbottom completed semi-annual duty weapon Firearms Qualifications with Firearms Instructor Lt. Bieri at the Indoor Range located at the Public Safety Center in Westampton.

DSgt. Chieffalo attended the Burlington County Detective Association monthly meeting on 6/22/22 at the Burlington Township Police Department.

Ptl. Rowbottom is currently assigned to a 3-month rotation in the Criminal Intelligence Unit.

<u>Criminal Complaints / Arrests:</u>

As a result of an investigation conducted by Det. Redfield, Kameron Gardenhire was identified and charged with robbery. The investigation stems from a robbery which occurred at the Wawa located at 570 Rancocas Road on 5/18/22 at 7:30 AM. Investigation revealed a male suspect in a white Hyundai Sonata bearing a NJ registration, stole \$75 in fuel and brandished a handgun when confronted about paying for the fuel. On 6/1/22, Det. Redfield identified and charged, Kameron Gardenhire, 20 years old of Willingboro with robbery. Gardenhire was arrested in Burlington City on the same date (6/1/22) for an unrelated charge and lodged in the Burlington County Jail. Gardenhire was processed on the Westampton charges and pending a court appearance.

As a result of an investigation conducted by Det. Redfield, Wade A. Burch, 41 of Camden, was identified and charged with multiple counts of burglary and theft. The investigation related to the charges began on 6/21/22, when Car Shop located at 1972 Burlington Mt. Holly Road reported several vehicles broken into overnight with various personal items removed from the vehicles. A review of Car Shop surveillance video located the suspect, described as a thin black male, wearing dark clothing with white stripes on the pants going car to car for a couple of hours. On 6/22/22 at approximately 1:52 AM, Westampton patrols encountered a male, wearing the same clothes in the parking lot of the old Walgreens located at 800 Woodlane Road. At this time, the suspect was identified as Wade A. Burch and arrested for an outstanding warrant and possession of Cocaine and drug paraphernalia. Burch was also found to be in possession of various stolen items taken from the vehicles at Car Shop. Following Burch's arrest, the National Weather Service located at 732 Woodlane Road, reported a laptop was stolen from one of their vehicles overnight. A review of the National Weather Service surveillance video located Burch, walking through the lot of the National Weather Service and entering a vehicle owned by the U.S. Department of Commerce and removing the laptop. This same laptop was recovered during the encounter with Burch in the Walgreens lot. On 6/27/22 at approximately 7:30 AM, Burch was arrested by the NJ Transit Police in Camden for an outstanding wanted persons warrant out of Westampton and Burlington City. After Burlington City PD processed Burch on their warrants, he was transported to the Westampton Township Police Department. At this time, Burch was processed on 5 complaints, each complaint reflected a separate count of burglary and theft. Burch was then transported and committed the Burlington County Jail and is pending court proceedings.

Other:

The Criminal Intelligence Unit is investigating a distraction motor vehicle burglary and theft which occurred on 6/16/22 at approximately 11:23 AM in the parking lot of the Home Depot located 2703 Burlington Mt. Holly Road. The victim reported that after returning to her vehicle from shopping at the Home Depot, she was approached at her car by a Hispanic male

who was trying to get her attention by holding up a lug nut in his hand and pointing at her rear passenger side tire. The victim exited her vehicle to see if her lug nut fell off but after determining nothing was wrong, she got back in her vehicle. She then observed the Hispanic male that approached her, walk up to another Hispanic male by the front doors of the Home Depot. At this time, the victim observed that her wallet containing \$35 in cash, a debit card, an insurance card and several gift cards were missing. It was later determined that an attempt to make a purchase with the victim's debit card occurred at the Home Depot in Delran but the card was declined. A review of Home Depot surveillance video from the Westampton and Delran stores assisted in locating four suspects, three males and a female who were all wearing surgical style masks, as well as their vehicle, a silver sedan with an unknown registration. Westampton Detectives are currently collaborating with the Northampton Township Police Department in Pennsylvania who are investigating a similar incident involving the same suspects and vehicle.

The Criminal Intelligence Unit is investigating a fraudulent purchase of a 2022 BMW M5 from J & S Autohaus located 1853 Burlington Mt. Holly Road on 6/14/22. Investigation revealed that four Asian males in a black Chevrolet Tahoe arrived in the dealership at approximately 7:30 PM on 6/14/22. One of the males had spoke with a sales associate earlier in the day regarding the purchasing of the vehicle. The male suspect presents a Chase Bank Cashier's Check, in the amount of \$198,811.00, a New York Driver's License and an Insurance Card to the dealership during the purchase and receives the vehicle. On 6/18/22, J & S received confirmation from the bank that the Cashier's Check was fraudulent. Further investigation by DSgt. Chieffalo confirmed that the Cashier's Check was once a legitimate check but was alerted by someone after the purchase. It was learned that a similar incident involving the same suspects occurred at World Wide BMW in Spring Valley, New York earlier the same day but the suspects left location when the dealership was trying to confirm the validity of the check. The BMW from J & S Autohaus is currently entered as a stolen vehicle and Westampton Detectives are currently collaborating with Detectives from the Spring Valley Police Department.

The Criminal Intelligence Unit completed three background investigations for police candidates enrolled in the hiring process.

Project Medicine Drop Report: During the month of June, 10.5 pounds of medication was collected for destruction at a later date. In addition, the Quarterly Collection Report was submitted which revealed 31 pounds of medication was collected during the 2nd Quarter of 2022. A destruction of 200 lbs of medication at Covanta in Camden, NJ was also completed on 6/2/22.

<u>Roads</u>

Brush: Brush collection this month brought in 15.68 tons of brush. The volume of brush slowed this month, Collection was completed in 6 days.

Street Repairs: DPW was called out to 16 Quailhollow Dr for a report of a dead tree on Township property behind their house. DPW determined the tree was a hazard and needed to be removed. The tree was too large and dangerous for us to handle so our tree contactor was called in for removal. DPW is keeping up with pothole repairs, we were again this month. There were two reports of storm drain backups to the DPW this month, The first was on Greenbrier Dr., After a heavy rainfall the drains were backing up in the street. An inspection of the outfalls determined that growth of vegetation in the outflows coupled with sediment build up from the blockage is causing the issue. DPW is working with Deerwood Country Club and the engineer to remedy the situation. The second was on East Dogwood Dr., DPW cleaned all the catch basins in the system and worked diligently to find the outflow for the drainage since we were unable to find prints on the system. We were able to find the outflow and determined that the outflow is completely covered and has a large tree in front of it, we are currently working with the engineer to determine the next course of action.

Recycling: A normal flow of requests for new cans and lid repairs continue, DPW is currently out of new cans, the latest update from the County OTC was that the cans would be in delivered at the end of August. THE TOWNSHIP WILL BE RE-INSTATING THE FEE FOR NEW CANS. THE COST IS 60\$ AND MUST BE PAID AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING BEFORE DELIVERY. THE FEE WAS BEING WAVED WHEN COVID HIT. We are fine with lid replacements and will continue to service those requests in a timely fashion.

Leaf Collection: Leaf collection will resume in fall.

Grass: Grass cutting is moving forward in a timely fashion.

Snow: Snow season has been wrapped up for the season.

Facilities

Municipal Building: DPW performed quarterly maintenance on the HVAC units this month, filters were changed and also a cleaning of the condenser and evaporator coils took place. DPW determined that this maintenance hasn't taken place in quite some time. It will be put on a bi-annual schedule to help the units run more efficiently. This maintenance also took place at the other Municipal owned buildings. The rear employee entrance door was also replaced this month and is working smoothly.

Sport complex\Parks: Spring Meadows: The Township has received the RFPs for replacement of the playset and are waiting on final approval from the council. The remaining repairs related to the tennis court are still in the works we are just working to fit the repairs into the schedule. Tarnsfield Park: DPW was able to complete the drainage around playsets this should help to get rid of the standing water that leaches from the play areas during rain and sits next to the playset walls. New sitting benches were also installed in a more convenient area so the parents can keep an eye on the children. Rolling Hills: The drainage was also installed around this playset as well to get rid of the standing water. New benches were installed by the pickleball court. DPW spent a little time at Tarnsfield Swim Club this month clearing back the brush next to the fence using our remote-control cutting machine. They also removing a hazardous piece of playground equipment from the playset. Power washing of the tennis court on Manor Dr took place this month and its back to tip top condition. DPW started prep work on the basketball courts at Holly Hills school, this work is needed in order to complete the re surfacing of the play area.

DPW Building: The shed that DPW is rehabbing is almost complete. The project is currently a secondary project and is mainly completed in off times. It will be wrapped up shortly.

ORDINANCE 7-2022

BOND ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF FIRE APPARATUS FOR THE TOWNSHIP WESTAMPTON, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$1,600,000 THEREFOR: AUTHORIZING THE **ISSUANCE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS** OR ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP WESTAMPTON, COUNTY OF **BURLINGTON, NEW** JERSEY IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF **UP TO \$1,520,000; MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS** AND COVENANTS: AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN RELATED ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE **FOREGOING**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Westampton, County of Burlington, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the provisions of the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of 1960 of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The purposes described in Section 7 hereof are hereby authorized as general improvements to be made or acquired by the Township of Westampton, County of Burlington, New Jersey ("Township").

Section 2. It is hereby found, determined and declared as follows:

- (a) the estimated amount to be raised by the Township from all sources for the purposes stated in Section 7 hereof is \$1,600,000;
- (b) the estimated amount of bonds or bond anticipation notes to be issued for the purposes stated in Section 7 hereof is \$1,520,000; and
- (c) a down payment in the amount of \$80,000 for the purposes stated in Section 7 hereof is currently available in accordance with the requirements of Section 11 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The sum of \$1,520,000, to be raised by the issuance of bonds or bond anticipation notes, together with the sum of \$80,000, which amount represents the required down payment, are hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in this bond ordinance ("Bond Ordinance").
- Section 4. The issuance of negotiable bonds of the Township in an amount not to exceed \$1,520,000 to finance the costs of the purposes described in Section 7 hereof is hereby authorized. Said bonds shall be sold in accordance with the requirements of the Local Bond Law.
 - <u>Section 5.</u> In order to temporarily finance the purposes described in Section 7 hereof,

the issuance of bond anticipation notes of the Township in an amount not to exceed \$1,520,000 is hereby authorized. Pursuant to the Local Bond Law, the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the bond anticipation notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver the same to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their date to delivery thereof. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby directed to report in writing to the governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the bond anticipation notes pursuant to this Bond Ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the bond anticipation notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

Section 6. The amount of the proceeds of the obligations authorized by this Bond Ordinance which may be used for the payment of interest on such obligations, accounting, engineering, legal fees and other items as provided in Section 20 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20, shall not exceed the sum of \$100,000.

Section 7. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which said obligations are to be issued; the estimated costs of each said purpose; the amount of down payment for each said purpose; the maximum amount obligations to be issued for each said purpose and the period of usefulness of each said purpose within the limitations of the Local Bond Law are as follows:

Purpose/Improvement

A Acquisition of a 100 Foot Ladder Truck for the Township Fire/EMS Department, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor or related thereto

Section 8. Grants or other monies received from any governmental entity, if any, will be applied to the payment of, or repayment of obligations issued to finance, the costs of the purposes described in Section 7 above.

Section 9. The supplemental debt statement provided for in Section 10 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-10, was duly filed in the office of the Clerk prior to the passage of this Bond Ordinance on first reading and a complete executed duplicate original thereof has been filed in the Office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey. The supplemental debt statement shows that the gross debt of the Township, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-43, is increased by this Bond Ordinance by \$1,520,000 and that the obligations authorized by this Bond Ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

<u>Section 10.</u> The full faith and credit of the Township are irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized by this Bond Ordinance, and to the extent payment is not otherwise provided, the Township shall levy <u>ad valorem</u> taxes on all taxable real property without limitation as to rate or amount for the payment thereof.

- Section 11. The Capital Budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Bond Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended Capital Budget and Capital Program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Clerk and available for inspection.
- Section 12. The Township hereby declares its intent to reimburse itself from the proceeds of the bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized by this Bond Ordinance pursuant to Income Tax Regulation Section 1.150-2(e), promulgated under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code"), for "original expenditures", as defined in Income Tax Regulation Section 1.150-2(c)(2), made by the Township prior to the issuance of such bonds or bond anticipation notes.

Section 13. The Township hereby covenants as follows:

- (a) it shall take all actions necessary to ensure that the interest paid on the bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized by the Bond Ordinance is exempt from the gross income of the owners thereof for federal income taxation purposes, and will not become a specific item of tax preference pursuant to Section 57(a)(5) of the Code;
- (b) it will not make any use of the proceeds of the bonds or bond anticipation notes or do or suffer any other action that would cause the bonds or bond anticipation notes to be "arbitrage bonds" as such term is defined in Section 148(a) of the Code and the Regulations promulgated thereunder;
- (c) it shall calculate or cause to be calculated and pay, when due, the rebatable arbitrage with respect to the "gross proceeds" (as such term is used in Section 148(f) of the Code) of the bonds or bond anticipation notes;
- (d) it shall timely file with the Internal Revenue Service such information report or reports as may be required by Sections 148(f) and 149(e) of the Code; and
- (e) it shall take no action that would cause the bonds or bond anticipation notes to be "federally guaranteed" within the meaning of Section 149(b) of the Code.
- <u>Section 14.</u> The improvements authorized hereby are not current expenses and are improvements that the Township may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.
- <u>Section 15.</u> All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **Section 16.** In accordance with the Local Bond Law, this Bond Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS

As permitted under NJS40A:4-46, local governments may make emergency appropriations, <u>after adoption of the annual budget</u>, for purposes unforeseen at the time of adoption. The total amount of an emergency appropriation shall be fully funded as a deferred charge in the succeeding fiscal year's budget, except if the appropriation is to be funded through the authorization of bonds pursuant to 40A:2-3.

If the emergency appropriation does not exceed 3% of the total of current and utility operating appropriations funded in the budget adopted for that year, the appropriation may be raised as a deferred charge outside CAP with Division approval, pursuant to 40A:4-48. If the emergency

appropriation, together with all other emergency appropriations made during the year, exceeds the 3%, the governing body, in its resolution, must request permission from the Director to exceed the limitation. Should the Director approve the emergency, the amount exceeding the 3% shall be raised as a deferred charge inside CAP in the next year's budget.

The Division reviews emergency appropriations to ensure that it meets the intent of the law. If the Division determines that the local government adopts an emergency as a result of purposefully under funding a budgetary appropriation, the local unit may be required to raise the emergency as a deferred charge inside CAP. Also, local governments must adopt the resolution upon occurrence of the emergency and submit the required documentation to the Division within 5 days of adoption. The Division may not approve an outside CAP appropriation if emergencies are not prepared and submitted timely.

The following documents are to be filed with the Division of Local Government Services for approval of an emergency appropriation made pursuant to NJS 40A:4-46:

- Two (2) certified copies of the resolution authorizing the emergency appropriation
- An affidavit of the Chief Financial Officer pursuant to NJS 40A:4-52

Emergency appropriations for down payments on capital improvements must be supported by an accounting of the Capital Improvement Fund for the period starting the beginning of the budget year up to the date of the introduction of the related ordinance.

It is permitted, but not mandatory, that an emergency authorization be financed by the issuance of notes. It may also be financed from available surplus funds pursuant to NJS 40A:4-50.

Where emergency notes are issued, they shall be designated as such, be renewed from time to time, and shall mature not later than the last day of the succeeding budget year. The Local Budget Law provides the form, etc. with respect to these notes under NJS 40A:4-51.
