WESTAMPTON TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE No. 8-2022

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTAMPTON, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY TO AMENDING CHAPTER 203 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTAMPTON ENTITLED "SOLICITORS AND CANVASSERS"

WHEREAS, the residents have brought to the attention concerns regarding solicitation in the residential neighborhoods of the Township; and

WHEREAS, Township has reviewed Chapter 203 of the Township <u>Code</u> entitled "Solicitors and Canvassers" and has determined that said Chapter needs to be updated to better protect the public from potentially dishonest or inappropriate vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Township makes these revisions keeping in mind an individual's right to fundamental protections under the U.S. and New Jersey Constitutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Township Council of the Township of Westampton, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 203 of the <u>Township</u> <u>Code of the Township of Westampton</u> entitled "Solicitors and Canvassers" be and is hereby amended to add section 203-12 as follows:

Section 1. Section 203 Solicitors and Canvassers shall be amended to include below:

§203-12 No Knock Registry.

- (A) There is hereby established a No Knock Registry to be maintained and updated monthly by the Township Clerk, including a list of addresses of premises within the Township where the owner or occupant has notified the Township that canvassing, soliciting, peddling, vending and door-todoor sales are not permitted on the premises.
- (B) Residents seeking to be placed on the No Knock Registry may annually register in person or by electronic means to be established by the Township, upon payment of an annual processing fee of \$5. The annual processing fee for a senior citizen or veteran is \$1. Upon registration, the resident will be issued a sticker to display at their premises indicating their enrollment on the No Knock Registry, which the resident shall prominently post for the year registered. The annual registration expires on December 31 of each year.
- (C) A printed or electronic copy of the No Knock Registry shall be provided to each registered solicitor or canvasser under this article by the Township Clerk during normal business hours. It shall be the obligation of the registered solicitor or canvasser to obtain a current, up-to-date copy of the No Knock Registry in effect at the time of canvassing and soliciting.
- (D) Any registered solicitor or canvasser disregarding or violating the No Knock Registry shall be banned from receiving a registered solicitor or canvasser for one calendar year from the date of violation, and subject to applicable penalties set forth in §203-10 of the Township Code. The existence or nonexistence of a "No Knock" sticker on the premises shall

not be a defense to the requirements of this article.

- Section 2. All Ordinances and provisions thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency
- **Section 3.** If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2023.

WESTAMPTON TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE No. 9-2022

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTAMPTON, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY TO AMENDING CHAPTER 88 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTAMPTON ENTITLED "LICENSE FEES"

WHEREAS, all persons who own, keep or harbor a dog within the Township of Westampton are required by N.J.S.A. 4:19-15.2 and Chapter 88 Article I Section 88-1 of the Township Code to annually apply for or renew a license for the dog; and

WHEREAS, the Township values those residents that are or have honorably served in the United States Armed Services; and

WHEREAS, in continuation of the Township's efforts to recognize those that are serving or have served in the United States' Military, the Township declares it in the best interest of the Township to provide said individuals with a reduction in the Dog Licensing fee; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Westampton, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 88, of the Westampton Township Code entitled "Animals" is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 88-4 License Fees shall be amended to include below:

§88-4 License Fees.

- (D) Any Veteran or Active Duty member of the United States Armed Services, as defined by 38 U.S.C. §101, shall be entitled to a reduction in the fee set forth in paragraph A of this section such that the sum to be paid annually by said veteran for a dog license shall be \$1.80 and the further sum of \$1 for the registration tag, and a surcharge of \$0.20 for low-cost spay-neuter clinic, for a total of \$3. Said veteran must provide valid proof of U.S. Military service and register as sole owner of licensed dog.
- Section 2. All Ordinances and provisions thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency
- **Section 3.** If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
- Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication in accordance with the law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

- Proactively notify veteran-owned businesses registered with NJ of each public bid opportunity
- IAW NJSA 40A:11-42(d) Make good faith efforts to award 6% of the total contract dollars to Veteran Business Enterprises.
- IAW NJSA 40A:11-42(d) For contracts awarded to non-veteran prime vendors, where there are not three qualified veteran bidders, we can request that 6% of the contract be awarded to qualified veteran subcontractors who are certified in the state of new jersey in the NJ Selective Assistance Vendor Info Database
- In the hiring of employees, the TWP, subject to all applicable civil service regulations shall make a good faith effort to achieve the goal of a minimum 5% veteran workforce
- Discount for veterans on local license and permit fees
- Preferred parking for veterans in Municipally owned lots
- Hold at least one patriot day public celebration honoring the service of veterans on Memorial Day, Veteran's Day and/or the anniversary of 9-11
- Public recognition of the service of a resident of the community who has served int he military on an annual basis
- Promote state fee exemption for local metered parking
- Provide parking spots for Purple Heart Recipients and Disabled Veterans
- Provide discounts to Veterans at local establishments or offer free discount booklets to Veterans
- Hold quarterly Veterans Round-tables
- Honor Veterans at least quarterly at Council meetings/special events
- Have local students bring Veteran Family members to speak at school
- Hold annual Memorial Day and Veterans Day ceremonies

- Provide discounts for community-based recreation (or similar municipal establishment)
- Hold Veteran Service Organization Meet and Greets
- List Veterans resources on the town website
- Honor and remember POW/MIA Day and Gold Star Families Day
- List Veteran owned businesses on the town website
- Offer scholarships to high school students of military families
- Volunteerism by municipal staff at Veteran related events (Memorial Day parades, Veteran Service Organization Meet and Greets, etc.
- Any initiatives or programs providing mental health resources for Veterans
- Any initiatives not on this list that your town has achieved towards helping/honoring local Veterans (e.g., Dedicating a park, street, memorial, etc. to a local Veteran)
