## Roads

**Brush:** Crews had a light month for brush collection, with a total of 23.52 tons of brush being picked up. It took the crews 5 days to complete the town rotation.

**Street Repairs:** Re-striping and configuration of the parking lot took place in the police parking area of the Municpal building, all parking lot improvements are now completed. Beaver is still active at Settlers ponds it's being mitigated by DPW via dam removal at the outflow of the pond. It is successful and will continue. Contracted repair work has started on the roads slated for paving in the township for this year. ETA for completion will be sometime in the end of July all dependent on the weather.

## **Facilities**

Grass: Crews are keeping up and on track with grass rotations.

**Municipal Building:** There were numerous false alarms with the fire panel this month. DPW worked in conjunction with fire alarm company, as well as, the Hvac contractor to sort out the issues related to those alarms. They were connected to a bad smoke head in the court office ans a bad motherboard in the HVAC system. DPW also repaired a faulty condensate pump for the HVAC in the police station.

**Sport complex\Parks:** Crews finished up backstop fence repairs. DPW also repaired some sprinkler heads in the ball fields. There were numerous issues with vanadalism at the Rolling Hills Park porta potty. DPW re-secured the cans and also placed a lock on the porta potty at the reccomendation of the Rec. Dept.

**DPW Building:** DPW crews completed overdue repairs on various areas on the addition section of our building. Replacement of siding and rotted wood were done. They have also started a over due paint job on the building.

## **Training:**

DSgt. Chieffalo and Det. Redfield attended a virtual training, "Effective Victim Interviewing: Beyond, Who, What, When, Where and Why", on 6/1/21 and 6/3/21 conducted by NJSP Victim Services Unit.

DSgt. Chieffalo attended a seminar, "Risk Management for Police Executives" presented by JIF at Merighi's Savoy Inn in Vineland, NJ on 6/8/21.

DSgt. Chieffalo Det. Redfield, and Det. Nagle attended a full day of departmental training which included firearms training, CPR recertification, Resiliency training and Tactical Emergency Causality Care training.

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## **Criminal Complaints / Arrests:**

6/9/21 - As a result of an investigation conducted by Det. Nagle, William Wise, 54 of Sicklerville, NJ was charged with 1 count of Burglary, 2 counts of Aggravated Criminal Sexual Contact, 2 Counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child and 2 counts of Harassment. The charges stem from an incident which occurred at the Red Roof Inn located at 2015 Burlington Mt. Holly Road on 6/9/21 at approximately 4:32 AM, where female occupants of one of the hotel rooms reported a strange male had entered their room. Investigation at the scene revealed, a male had entered a room on the second floor of the hotel and had sexual contact with female victims that were sleeping in the room. With the assistance of hotel surveillance video Wise was identified as the suspect and detained by patrols. Further investigation was conducted by Westampton Twp Detectives, consisting of interviews and reviewing of hotel surveillance video. The hotel surveillance video confirmed that Wise enters the victim's room remaining inside a few minutes, before exiting and returning a couple minutes later, this time remaining inside for just over 15 minutes before running out of the room and down the hallway.

The victim's in this incident, two 17 and two 18 year old females were part of a large religious group of recent high school graduates from the State of Utah, who were participating in an organized two week nationwide religious history tour, which stopped at the Red Roof Inn for a one night stay before moving on to New York City.

Wise was incarcerated on all charges and is pending a court hearing.

6/24/21 - As a result of an investigation conducted by DSgt. Chieffalo, Samuel Padilla, 34 Toms River was identified and charged with shoplifting, related to an incident that occurred on 6/14/21 at Kohl's Department Store located at 2703 Burlington Mt. Holly Road. This case is pending the arrest and processing of Padilla.

## Other:

The Criminal Intelligence Unit is investigating an armed robbery which occurred at the Lukoil located at 584 Rancocas Road on 6/1/21 at approximately 7:44 PM. Investigation at the scene revealed the suspect, described as a black male, wearing black shoes, a black hooded sweatshirt with the word "Cookies" across the front with the hood pulled up, a black wool hat, a black mask covering the lower portion of his face to the bridge of his nose and sunglasses, enters the gas station store and confronts the gas attendant. As the gas attendant removes cash from his pocket, the suspect grabs the cash, then rummages through the desk, removing a plastic container of loose change. The suspect then grabs several boxes of cigarillos on display in the store and runs off on foot down Highland Drive.

The Criminal Intelligence Unit is investigating a no-hit shooting which occurred on 6/16/21 at 12:06 AM in the area of the 700 Building of Downing Court in the Westampton Courts Condominium Complex. Investigation at the scene, recovered two spent 40 caliber casings, a 9 mm round and a 40 caliber handgun which was confirmed stolen out of South Carolina. Several subjects / persons of interest have been identified and further investigation is

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pending. There were no injuries or damage observed at the scene.

## **ORDINANCE 6-2021**

BOND ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF VARIOUS CAPITAL EQUIPMENT IN AND FOR THE **TOWNSHIP** WESTAMPTON. **OF** COUNTY BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$1,058,590 THEREFOR; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE **GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS** OR ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP WESTAMPTON, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF **UP TO \$1,005,590; MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS** AND COVENANTS: AND AUTHORIZING RELATED ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE **FOREGOING** 

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Westampton, County of Burlington, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the provisions of the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of 1960 of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The purposes described in Section 7 hereof are hereby authorized as general improvements to be made or acquired by the Township of Westampton, County of Burlington, New Jersey ("Township").

## **Section 2.** It is hereby found, determined and declared as follows:

- (a) the estimated amount to be raised by the Township from all sources for the purposes stated in Section 7 hereof is \$1,058,590;
- (b) the estimated amount of bonds or bond anticipation notes to be issued for the purposes stated in Section 7 hereof is \$1,005,590; and
- (c) a down payment in the amount of \$53,000 for the purposes stated in Section 7 hereof is currently available in accordance with the requirements of Section 11 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11.
- Section 3. The sum of \$1,005,590, to be raised by the issuance of bonds or bond anticipation notes, together with the sum of \$53,000, which amount represents the required down payment, are hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in this bond ordinance ("Bond Ordinance").
- Section 4. The issuance of negotiable bonds of the Township in an amount not to exceed \$1,005,590 to finance the costs of the purposes described in Section 7 hereof is hereby authorized. Said bonds shall be sold in accordance with the requirements of the Local Bond Law.
  - Section 5. In order to temporarily finance the purposes described in Section 7 hereof,

the issuance of bond anticipation notes of the Township in an amount not to exceed \$1,005,590 is hereby authorized. Pursuant to the Local Bond Law, the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the bond anticipation notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver the same to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their date to delivery thereof. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby directed to report in writing to the governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the bond anticipation notes pursuant to this Bond Ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the bond anticipation notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

Section 6. The amount of the proceeds of the obligations authorized by this Bond Ordinance which may be used for the payment of interest on such obligations, accounting, engineering, legal fees and other items as provided in Section 20 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20, shall not exceed the sum of \$210,000.

Section 7. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which said obligations are to be issued; the estimated costs of each said purpose; the amount of down payment for each said purpose; the maximum amount obligations to be issued for each said purpose and the period of usefulness of each said purpose within the limitations of the Local Bond Law are as follows:

Section 8. The average period of useful life of the several purposes for the financing of which this Bond Ordinance authorizes the issuance of bonds or bond anticipation notes, taking into consideration the respective amounts of bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized for said several purposes, is not less than 9.29 years.

- Section 9. Grants or other monies received from any governmental entity, if any, will be applied to the payment of, or repayment of obligations issued to finance, the costs of the purposes described in Section 7 above.
- Section 10. The supplemental debt statement provided for in Section 10 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-10, was duly filed in the office of the Clerk prior to the passage of this Bond Ordinance on first reading and a complete executed duplicate original thereof has been filed in the Office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey. The supplemental debt statement shows that the gross debt of the Township, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-43, is increased by this Bond Ordinance by \$1,005,590 and that the obligations authorized by this Bond Ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.
- Section 11. The full faith and credit of the Township are irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized by this Bond Ordinance, and to the extent payment is not otherwise provided, the Township shall levy <u>ad valorem</u> taxes on all taxable real property without limitation as to rate or amount for the payment thereof.
- Section 12. The Capital Budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Bond Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended Capital Budget and Capital Program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Clerk and available for inspection.
- Section 13. The Township hereby declares its intent to reimburse itself from the proceeds of the bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized by this Bond Ordinance pursuant to Income Tax Regulation Section 1.150-2(e), promulgated under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code"), for "original expenditures", as defined in Income Tax Regulation Section 1.150-2(c)(2), made by the Township prior to the issuance of such bonds or bond anticipation notes.

## **Section 14.** The Township hereby covenants as follows:

- (a) it shall take all actions necessary to ensure that the interest paid on the bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized by the Bond Ordinance is exempt from the gross income of the owners thereof for federal income taxation purposes, and will not become a specific item of tax preference pursuant to Section 57(a)(5) of the Code;
- (b) it will not make any use of the proceeds of the bonds or bond anticipation notes or do or suffer any other action that would cause the bonds or bond anticipation notes to be "arbitrage bonds" as such term is defined in Section 148(a) of the Code and the Regulations promulgated thereunder;
- (c) it shall calculate or cause to be calculated and pay, when due, the rebatable arbitrage with respect to the "gross proceeds" (as such term is used in Section 148(f) of the Code) of the bonds or bond anticipation notes;
- (d) it shall timely file with the Internal Revenue Service such information report or reports as may be required by Sections 148(f) and 149(e) of the Code; and

- (e) it shall take no action that would cause the bonds or bond anticipation notes to be "federally guaranteed" within the meaning of Section 149(b) of the Code.
- <u>Section 15.</u> The improvements authorized hereby are not current expenses and are improvements that the Township may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.
- <u>Section 16.</u> All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- Section 17. In accordance with the Local Bond Law, this Bond Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

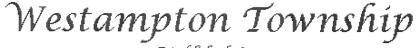
