




January 2021


In 2021, EMS calls account for 76% of the departments call volume followed by 16% for fire responses, lastly motor vehicle accidents make up 7% of the Departments call volume. (<1% are missed/error call dispatches)





CALENDAR YEAR 2021 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

ORDINANCE NO. 3-2021

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 1.0% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Committee of the Township of Westampton in the County of Burlington finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2021 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Committee hereby determines that a 2.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$254,735.58 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Committee hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Committee of the Township of Westampton, in the County of Burlington, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2021 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Westampton shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$356,629.81, and that the CY 2021 municipal budget for the Township of Westampton be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.


WHEREAS, the Township of Westampton was awarded \$250,000 from NJDOT in FY 2019 for improvements to Lambert and Forceville Drives; and

On behalf of the Township of Westampton, we are requesting a 6-month extension of time to award a construction contract for the referenced project. The Township was notified by letter from NJDOT, dated March 25, 2019, that it was awarded \$250,000 in FY 2019 Municipal Aid funding for improvements to Lambert Drive and Forceville Drive. The Township was subsequently awarded an additional \$243,000 under the FY 2020 funding for improvements to Lambert Drive, Forceville Drive, and Tallowood Drive. The Township plans use the combined funding (FY2019 and 2020) to undertake these improvements with one construction contract. Undertaking the project with the combined funds will provide for more cost-effective use of these funds.

RE:

The extension of time is requested due to the following extraordinary circumstances:

- The declaration of a state of emergency by the Governor of New Jersey due to COVID-19 as well as the stay at home order has impacted the Township staffing and the Township budget. The staffing issues and the budget concerns delayed the award of the design contract until 2021.
- The Township is in the process of coordinating with utility companies regarding any work required within the project limits.

Westampton Township will adopt a Resolution requesting an extension of time to September 25, 2021 for award of a construction contract at their next Committee meeting on March 2, 2021. A copy of this Resolution will be forwarded immediately after it is adopted.

Although the maximum 6-month extension is requested, the following schedule is anticipated:

- Advertise for Bids: March 31, 2021.
- Receive Bids: April 21, 2021.
- Award Contract: May 4, 2021.


