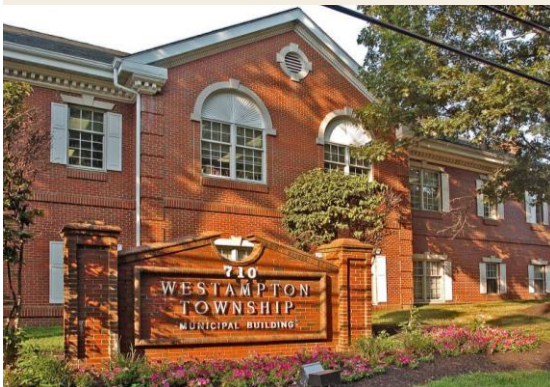

Fire Prevention Week!

To our Residents,

Each year in October, we as a nation remember the Great Chicago Fire of 1871, which resulted in the deaths of more than 250 people, left 100,000 without homes, and destroyed more than 17,400 structures. Remembering this historic event helps us to understand the importance of fire safety, fire codes and personal preparedness. Annually a theme for Fire Prevention Week is designated by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) to encourage Americans to look at the fire safety issues in their homes. This year's theme is: "Fire won't wait. Plan your escape". Today's homes burn faster than ever. You may have as little as two minutes (or even less time) to safely escape a home fire from the time the smoke alarm sounds. Your ability to get out of a home during a fire depends on early warning from smoke alarms and advance planning.

During the month of October, Westampton Township Emergency Services hosts an **Open House at our Fire House, located at 780 Woodlane Road. The event takes place from 6 pm until 9 pm on October 13th.** This year, we will have Food Trucks for you to purchase food from. We will also have demonstrations and lots of safety messages for you and your family to take home with you. We also visit each daycare within Westampton, along with our public and private schools, during the month to ensure we reach as many people as we can.

And as always continue to serve the wonderful town of Westampton.

90 Gallon Recycling cans are in! Please come to the municipal building to reserve one.

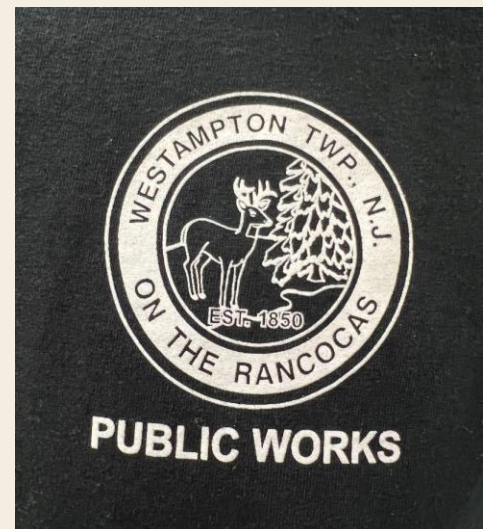

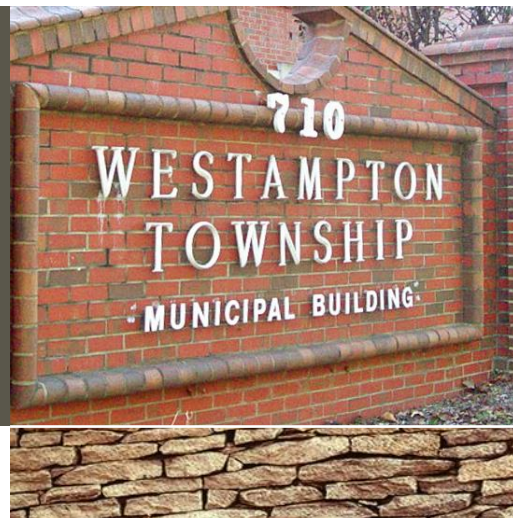
